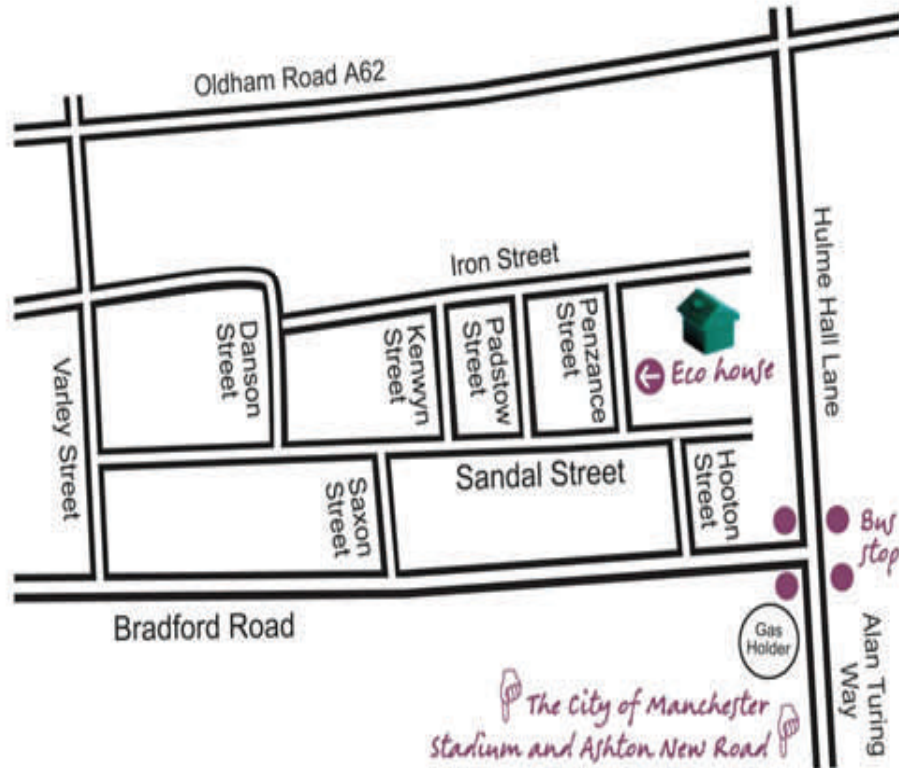

# Manchester Eco House





The Eco house is a typical example of pre 1930's terraced housing, classed as 'hard to heat' due to it's solid wall construction.

Come and see the various energy efficient measures we have Installed that have reduced fuel bills by 55% and reduce Co2 emissions by 63% achieving a rating of 'very good' under the BRE Eco Homes criteria.

The house introduces energy efficiency in a practical 'hands on' environment. Demonstrating external and internal wall Insulation, cavity wall insulation, efficient heating systems, low energy lighting and much more.



Tours can accommodate up to 10 people, the Eco House can also be hired for meetings and as a training venue for up to 15 and is also suitable for School, and University visits.

The visit is a unique opportunity for any one interested in learning about the various measures, behavioural changes and savings that can be made when improving the energy efficiency of the home.



There is also an introduction to renewable energy with a solar thermal hot water system and sun pipe with photovoltaic panel.

The bike shed made from FSC wood, has a green roof to attract wildlife and absorb rainwater.

We also have a wormery, recycling and water saving devices for consideration
